Dear Industrial Waste Generator:

Wasatch Integrated Waste Management District is a Special Service District, owned by Davis and Morgan Counties and 15 cities, which operates a fully integrated waste management system. The District has been given the mission to protect public health by using state-of-the-art methods to process, recycle, reduce, and reuse our garbage.

Currently, the District is in the process of updating its Solid Waste Management Plan. In order to most appropriately plan for future disposal needs, it is important to gain a clear understanding of the quantities and types of waste that are generated and how they are currently managed within the District.

The District has contracted with Gershman, Brickner & Bratton, Inc. (GBB), a national solid waste management consulting firm based in Fairfax, Virginia, to collect information regarding waste generation, disposal, and recycling within Davis and Morgan Counties, and assist in updating the Solid Waste Management Plan. I encourage you to participate in GBB's brief waste survey which can be accessed and submitted securely online by visiting our website, www.wiwmd.org. The survey is located on the home page. We ask that you complete the survey by December 9th. Within the next few weeks, you may receive a telephone call from GBB with follow-up questions or inquiries. Your response will assist the District in assessing the solid waste management needs of Davis and Morgan Counties, and effectively planning for the future.
