PLEASE READ IMPORTANT E-WASTE INFORMATION

The EPA has determined that Cathode Ray Tubes (CRTs) in color computer monitors and televisions **are considered hazardous waste** when discarded because of the presences of lead in the CRT. Due to the potential for any/all electronic waste (e-waste) to be classified as a hazardous waste, **Wasatch Integrated Waste Management District will accept household quantities (a maximum of two [2] of any one type e-waste item) from residential customers ONLY.** All other customers should be referred to electronics waste recyclers or hazardous waste disposal facilities.

All e-waste (computer monitors, hard drives, televisions, stereo equipment, copy machines, faxes, cell phones, electronic games, etc.) from businesses and other organizations will be considered **hazardous waste and cannot be accepted at this facility.**

E-waste is short for electronic waste and is the term applied to consumer electronic equipment or electrical products that are no longer wanted. E-waste can include computers, computer monitors, printers, televisions, VCRs, cell phones, fax machines, stereos, and electronic games.

E-waste can be brought to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility at the landfill, during regular operating hours, Monday through Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Summer Hours) or Monday through Saturday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Winter Hours). There is no charge for **household quantities** of e-waste, providing the e-waste is from a household. Regular fees will apply to waste which is not household hazardous; \$5 per pick up or single axle trailer load (flat fee) or \$26 per ton for double axle trailers and larger vehicles.
