Re: Permanent Closure of the Energy Recovery Facility

Dear Special Waste Customer:

It is with deep regret that Wasatch Integrated Waste Management District announces the permanent closure of the Davis Energy Recovery Facility (incinerator). For the past 30 years the facility has provided economical and efficient waste disposal for special waste, municipal solid waste, and commercial waste customers while supplying renewable energy to Hill Air Force Base.

The facility is being closed in response to a number of factors, including increasing costs associated with maintaining an aging facility, cost of additional pollution control equipment, and a reduced need for supplied steam.

Closure of the facility is scheduled for May 31, 2017. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, waste will be scheduled and accepted through, Friday, May 19, 2017. Every effort will be made to accommodate all requests for special waste disposal.

Wasatch continues to offer secure disposal at the Davis Landfill. We are currently compiling a list of alternative options for incineration and will have information on our website as soon as possible, [www.wasatchintegrated.org](http://www.wasatchintegrated.org).
